Bill serves as moderator and producer for this "done-facing" episodic video content, which includes interviews and guest appearances by those interested in faith without religion, Girardian social theory, and modern "small-I" libertarianism. Significant guests have included Dr Jo Jorgenson and Spike Cohen, the "bronze medal" contestants in the American Presidential election of 2016, and the Acton Institute producer and public relations director of the award-winning documentary film about Jimmy Lai, "The Hong Konger." Serenity

Bill's first book, "[More Than Human](#)", resulted from his leadership as Champion of the San Diego Veterans Coalition Spiritual Working Group. It became an Amazon international best-seller on the day of the 2017 solar eclipse. The book is used extensively in Bill's transformational coaching practice.

In Our Eyes - In Our Words: Portraits from the Edge of Society

Bill is publisher and editorial contributor to this award-winning fine art book of portraits of homeless Californians drawn from life by California fine-art painter Jeffrey C Horn. Almost 1,000 copies of "[In Our Eyes In Our Words](#)" have been presented to Southern California not-for-profit organizations that do significant work to help people without doors come home. While the book is available in limited supply, it's publishing and distribution rights are intended to be sold to a major publisher.

Together with award-winning sound healer and Tibetan bowl teacher Diáne Mandle, Bill provides the "Western" keyboard, synth, and ambiance to the bliss-inducing next-level sound bath called [Anandamaya](#), which is now represented by [Bollatta Entertainment](#).

Musimorphic

Since the mid-90s, Bill's one-man lecture/performance show has entertained, educated, and engaged more than 300,000 people in concert halls, theaters, clubs, and seminars across America, culminating with an Award of Excellence from the National Council for Behavioral Health Care in 2016, the industry equivalent of winning an Oscar.

This ongoing role is supported by the online [Musimorphic Quest](#), which he developed and launched in 2016, and through his current position as Founder and Consulting Educator for Music Care Inc, dba Musimorphic. [Bill welcomes sincere Passengers to the Quest, particularly people who understand that change is inevitable, that relationship comes first, and who no longer satisfied with their status quo.](#)
